What is Hospice?

Hospice is a medical benefit covered by Medicare and most private insurance.

- The program focuses on the quality of life and comfort for patients and families in the last phases of a life-limiting illness.

What type of payments do we accept?

- Medicare, Medi-Cal, and some private insurance.
- For Medicare and most Medi-Cal programs, there are no out-of-pocket cost.

Hospice Physician

- Works conjointly with the patient's primary care physician and the rest of the interdisciplinary team.
- Physician's home visits may be arranged for patients as needed.

Registered Nurse

- Patient's plan of care and is the family's main point of contact.
- Oversees patient's symptom management and pain control.
- Educates caregivers on the patient's care.
- Maintains communication and coordination with everyone involved in the patient's care.

Hospice Aide

- Assists in personal care of the patient including bathing, feeding, mouth care, etc.
- Performs light housekeeping around the patient's area.

Social Worker

- Addresses the emotional & psychosocial needs of both the patient and family members.
- Helps to resolve financial and placement issues.
- Assists with end-of-life preparations including funeral arrangements.

Spiritual Care Counselor

- Provides spiritual support for patients and family members, & works with patient's clergy as needed.

Hospice Volunteer

- Specially trained volunteers are available to spend time with the patient to offer companionship and provides some relief for family when arranged in advance.
